

Editorial


Welcome to the next issue of Chronicle!

USIEF to expand its reach in J&K through SMVDU

United States India E d u c a t i o n a l F o u n d a t i o n (UISEF) which is responsible for administering the F u l b r i g h t F e l l o w s h i p programme in India is holding a workshop to evolve strategies to



increase representation from the underserved areas like Jammu and Kashmir, USIEF New Delhi has recently announced a new round of fellowships for 2010. This fellowship programme which is one of the prestigious programmes in the world is applicable to students, researchers, professionals and faculty members for study and research in the US. Fulbright programme which is also one of the largest fellowship programmes in the world has over 16200 fellows so far under its exchange programme. In order to promote visibility of Fulbright programme particularly in the underserved areas like Jammu & Kashmir which has only 16 Fulbright fellows between 2001-08 compared to 203 from Delhi during the same period, USIEF is conducting this workshop. In this workshop over 40 Fulbright Campus Representatives and an equal number of Fulbright Alumni apart from the representatives of USIEF and USAID shall be participating. Out of all the 40 campus representatives, Dr. Sunil Kumar Wanchoo, Assistant Professor, Fulbright Campus Representative from SMVD University has been given an exclusive slot to make a presentation on Challenges and Strategies in reaching out to educational Institutions and Society in the State of Jammu and Kashmir. As a part of USIEFs continued effort to recruit scholars from underserved areas

Dr. Wanchoo's presentation is expected to help USIEF to come up with a renewed effort for increasing the representation of Jammu and Kashmir in the prestigious Fulbright programme.

USIEF has shown keen interest in the activities being undertaken by SMVD University for the promotion of Education and awareness among students from different schools and colleges in last five years under the banner of National Science Day. This has resulted in a strong association between SMVD University and USIEF in last couple of years. USIEF had held its first outreach programme in Jammu and Kashmir in SMVD University last year. As part of the continued effort in this direction USIEF had deputed Prof. V. K. Jindal, Punjab University to deliver the Sir C V Raman Memorial public lecture on Nanotechnology and Nanomaterials on National Science Day – 2009.

Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University has started admission process for the session 2009-10. Admission to various course of B. Tech is made by the University based upon AIEEE ranking. A Large number of candidates from the Jammu & Kashmir State participate in AIEEE and they had to travel to different Centres outside the J&K State for Counselling by Central Counselling Board. The candidates belonging to Jammu and Kashmir desired to have AIEEE Counselling Centre in the state so that the aspiring candidates do not have to travel outside the state for the Counselling for B. Tech. /B.Arch. Programme.

Last year SMVD University took first step to have a Counselling Centre on trial basis in the



campus and it proved successful. The admission committee of SMVDU took up the matter with concerned authorities and made efforts, as a result of which the Central Counselling Board (CCB) allotted a full-fledged Counselling Centre at SMVDU for Counselling/Admission in B.Tech./B.Arch on the basis of AIEEE 2009 ranking to facilitate the students of the State.

The Counselling Centre at SMVDU will provide Registration, filling up the choices, showing Indicative allotment (MOCK Counselling) and Locking. There will be four rounds of Counselling as directed by CCB. In first round of Counselling comprises of Registration, exercising the choice and locking, for which June 28, 2009 is the last date. First round of seat allotment will take place on 30th June 2009 and 2nd, 3rd and 4th round on July 07, July13 and July 19, 2009 respectively. Accordingly the reporting at Admission Centre will start from 1st July 09 onwards till 24th July 2009.

AIEEE rank is the only criterion for seeking admission in UG Programme at SMVDU. For further detailed information you may visit www.ccb.nic.in, www.smvdu.ac.in.
