1. The offer of admission to the program is **purely provisional** subject to the candidate meeting the eligibility criteria i.e.,
 - a. BE/B.Tech or Equivalent degree with at-least 50% aggregate marks or equivalent CGPA in CSE/ECE/IT discipline from a recognized University/Institute.
 - b. For candidates having a valid GATE rank - Selection shall be based on the score obtained by the candidate in the GATE examination subject to the candidate having obtained at-least 50% aggregate percentage in the qualifying degree (in case final year result is awaited then the aggregate percentage obtained till and including the pre-final year of the qualifying degree with no active backlogs till pre-final year). Candidates who are already meeting the eligibility criteria shall be given preference.
 - c. For candidates Not having a valid GATE rank - Selection based on the aggregate percentage of the student in the qualifying degree (in case final year result is awaited then the aggregate percentage obtained till and including the pre-final

year of the qualifying degree with no active backlogs till pre-final year)subject to the aggregate percentage being at-least 50%. Rank in merit list will be based on the aggregate percentage obtained and in case of percentage being same, higher rank will be assigned to the older student based on Date of Birth.

It may be noted that the admission granted, for both type of candidates, will be purely provisional in nature, subject to the candidate meeting the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Section 5.2(b) of the Admission Brochure 2021-2022

2. ***For candidates who have completed their Qualifying Degree:*** In case they fail to meet the eligibility criteria as mentioned above, on verification of relevant educational documents etc., their provisional admission offered by the University shall stand terminated without any further notice and the fee submitted will be forfeited.
3. ***For candidates who have appeared/are appearing in their qualifying examination and the regular examination results of which are yet to be declared:*** They will be required to submit the proof of having met the eligibility criteria latest by 15th September 2021 (the date may be extended beyond 15th September 2021, by the University, subjected to prevailing conditions) failing which the admission granted shall stand terminated without any further notice and the fee submitted will be forfeited.
4. **Refund policy for students admitted during Academic Session 2021-22:** As per the Refund policy notified vide no. SMVDU/AA/21/778-782 dated: 10th August 2021 which is "In view of the financial hardships being faced by parents due to lockdowns and related factors, a full refund of fees should be made on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students up to October 31, 2021 for the academic session 2021-2022 as a special case. It is made clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (i.e. there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellations/ migrations up to October 31, 2021. Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admissions up to December 31, 2021, the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not more than Rs.1000/- as processing fee."

For admission, cancellation and refund cases received after 31st Dec., 2021, the refund rule of the University, already in place shall be applicable with the date of closure being considered as notified by concerned schools from time to time and Tier 3-5 of the refund fee rules shall be applicable.
