About Surinsar Wetland

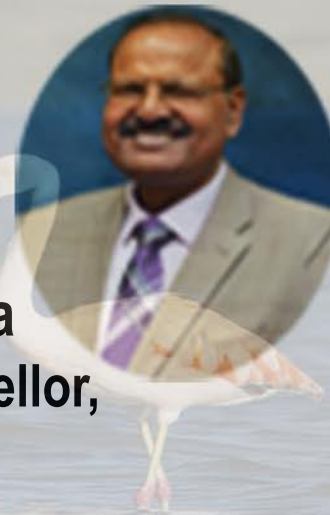


Surang Sar lake popularly known as Surinsar Lake is a beautiful lake surrounded by hills and dense forests situated near Jammu city. Surinsar lake is in close proximity of Mansar Lake and both are considered as twin lakes. On 8 November 2005 Surinsar lake along with Mansar Lake were officially designated as Ramsar Wetlands as Surinsar-Mansar Lakes. The Surinsar Mansar Wildlife Sanctuary is located in the midst of both lakes. In view of World Wetlands Day, the School of Biotechnology, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, Katra is organising a visit to a local wetland on 02 February 2023.
