#### Fifth Convocation Addressed by PM

The 5th Convocation of the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University was held on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 in the Matrika Auditorium of University campus. The Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi, was the Chief Guest on the occasion and gave away the Chancellor's Gold Medal to five students; Vice Chancellor's Gold Medal to one student; Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board Medal to four students; Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board Medal Best Girl student to two students; University Silver Medal to ten students; and Infosys Foundation Prize for Excellence to sixteen girl students. The Governor Sh. N. N. Vohra, who is Chancellor of the University, presided over the Convocation while Chief Minister Ms. Mehbooba Mufti, Dr. Jitendra Singh MoS (PMO) and Dr. Nirmal Singh, Deputy Chief Minister were the Guests of Honour on the occasion.

The Chancellor conferred degrees on students, which included Doctor of Philosophy [in Management, Mathematics, Physics, Biotechnology, English, Philosophy, Computer Science & Engineering, and Electronics & Communication Engineering]; Master of Technology [in Computer Science & Engineering and Electronics & Communication Engineering]; Master of Business Administration & Master of Business Administration [in Business Economics]; Master of Science [in Mathematics, Physics and Biotechnology]; Master of Arts [in English and Philosophy]; Bachelor of Technology [in Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Industrial Biotechnology] and Bachelor of Architecture.

In his address, the Chancellor congratulated all those who received degrees at the Convocation and wished them high success in their future careers. He also complimented all those who were presented medals, certificates and awards by the Prime Minister. The Governor said that it is a proud moment for the University that Prime Minister Narendra Modi is among them and addressing the Convocation. He said that this important event had assumed added significance as a little while earlier the Prime Minister had inaugurated the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Narayana Super Specialty Hospital, in the immediate neighborhood of the University, thus fulfilling another long awaited dream of the Shrine Board to contribute towards providing better healthcare for the people at large, at affordable prices. Recalling the objectives of the establishment of the University, the Governor said that this institution aims at achieving excellence in



teaching and research along with nurturing sound moral, ethical and spiritual values among students, crucial for the holistic development of youth and making them valuable members of the society. The Governor said that, by all account, the students graduating from this University are imbued with ethical values, besides being well trained in their chosen areas of specialization, which makes them distinct from their counterpart in other Universities. He mentioned that this University, in spite of being very young, finds the 80th place among the top 100 Universities in the country, based on a recent survey conducted by the Union Ministry of HRD.

In his Convocation Address, the Prime Minister, Sh. Narendra Modi said that India will rule the 21st century which is the era of knowledge and with 800 million youths below the age of 35 years, the dream of every young person can become a progress story of this country. Further, the PM said a unique feature of this university is that while other varsities in the country are run by tax payers' money, SMVDU is being funded by millions of poor people who come to pay obeisance to Vaishno Devi shrine. Therefore, it is the duty of every student to take a pledge that they will do something for the poor, because it was the poor pilgrim who contributed to build this University and indirectly contributed towards their growth. Invoking former President A P J Abdul Kalam, the Prime Minister said, "You don't only need facilities but dedication too. Kalam, who laid the foundation stone of this University and was known as the Missile Man, at one time used to sell newspapers". Modi said that if facilities were everything then the people who have all such facilities should have achieved everything in life but that was not the case.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister, Ms. Mehbooba Mufti shared her reminiscences about her visits to the holy shrine and expressed satisfaction about the progress of SMVDU particularly at the fact that girls students are outnumbering boy students in fetching awards and medals. Earlier, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Sanjeev Jain gave a detailed report of the University, its' activities and progress made over the past three years after the ceremonial arrival of Convocation Procession in the hall, which comprised of the Chief Guest, Guests of Honour, Chancellor, members of Executive Council, Academic Council led by Registrar, Sh.Ajay Khajuria.

Vohra visited the University campus on 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2016 to give away prizes to First Inter-State (North Zone) Declamation Contest winners followed by inauguration of TEDx SMVDU and TBIC website launch. The objective of Inter-State (North Zone) Declamation Contest instituted by Hon'ble Governor and

Chancellor is to inculcate among youth sensitivity about the emergent issues of society. Organized by Board of Cultural Activities under the aegis of Dean of Students' Office, nineteen students participated from different institution of the state in the Inter-State Declamation Contest who were adjudged by a team of three jury members chaired by Shri S.K Sharma, member J&K Public Service Commission, Dr. Anindya Gowswami, IIIM Jammu and Shri Ashutosh Sharma, CEO, International committee for Development & Regional Cooperation. The contest began with the welcome address by Dr. V.K Tripathi, President BCA who shared his



views on the theme of the contest "Ethics and morality are no longer relevant to the modern word", taking into consideration one of the major crises of the contemporary society, i.e., degradation of moral commitment among the highly educated professionals. Shri S.K Sharma also presented his views by citing examples of unethical practices going around, affecting political, social and economic scenario and degrading public life and values affecting society. The participants were given a chance to question and think about the necessity of morality in public life and its relevance to build a morally sensitive society. Moreover, the participants were given an opportunity to interact with and learn from the students participating from different universities. The key constraints in imparting such values to society, mentioned by the speakers comprised of lacking similarity in vision, the 'l' attitude among individuals, disequilibrium between developmental goals and moral values etc. Institutions from across the northern states including Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, and Rajasthan participated in the event.

The Valedictory Session was chaired by Sh. N. N. Vohra, the Hon'ble Governor and Chancellor. After evaluation of the participants on the basis of content, diction, stage presence and presentation, the Silver Rolling Trophy instituted by Hon'ble Governor, was awarded to Shivika Thakur, of Jammu University who emerged as the winning speaker with the highest marks. Second and third position was bagged by Seerat Baji, GCW Gandhi Nagar, Jammu and Rajat Srivastava of NIT Srinagar respectively.



#### **Chancellor Launched TBIC Website**

Sh. N. N. Vohra, the Hon'ble Governor and Chancellor of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University (SMVDU), launched the website (www.smvdutbic.org) of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University Technology Business Incubation Center (SMVDU-TBIC). The SMVDU-TBIC will work under the supervision of Prof. Sanjeev Jain, Vice Chancellor, SMVDU as chairperson of Governing Council and

Managing Committee of SMVDU-TBIC. Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University Technology Business Incubation Center Society (SMVDU TBIC) is established at Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, Kakrial, Katra with the Grant-in-aid jointly from NSTEDB, Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India and Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University. SMVDU-TBIC is the first ever Technology Business Incubator in the State of J&K and Himachal Pradesh and has been identified as one of the sixty-eight Incubators to recommend Startups under Startup India Initiative of Government of India.



The main objective of the Incubation center is to identify potential Entrepreneurs in North India, especially in the State of Jammu-Kashmir, nurture and support innovations, develop technology based ideas into independent self-sustaining business. The Thrust areas are Biotechnology (Microbial, Plant, Medical Genetics and Diagnostics), Engineering (Electronics, Robotics, E-commerce, GSM/GPRS based Technology, Alternative Energy Management) and Business Development. However, the incubator intends to facilitate any technology-based idea with potential to develop into a successful business as well as small-scale business with potential to grow into big industry. The launch of the website opens a gateway to connect potential entrepreneurs to the Business incubation Center. Dr. Swarkar Sharma has been appointed Interim-CEO of the SMVDU-TBIC and center now invites rolling preliminary applications through their website.
