SMVDU Hosted an International Conference on Emerging Trends in Biosciences and Chemical Technology



A three-day international conference on "Emerging Trends in Biosciences and Chemical Technology-2022" was hosted by School of Biotechnology, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University in collaboration with CSIR-IIIM, Jammu and BRSI from 3rd to 5th December, 2022. The chief guest of the international conference was Dr.Jitendra Singh, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for the Ministry of Science and Technology. Prof. Manoj Kumar Dhar, a distinguished scientist and former Vice Chancellor of the University of Jammu, was the guest of honour. This conference provided a forum for the exchange of ideas, the generation of new concepts, and the discussion of contemporary concerns in the biological and chemical sciences. The conference was attended by eminent scientists, professors and scholars from academia and industry to discuss the future trends in biosciences and chemical technology with the purpose of undertaking the challenges in the field. The conference consisted of thirteen sessions of varied plenary speeches and quest lectures by famous scientists from Argentina, Brazil, Greece, Malaysia, Mexico, Singapore, South Korea, Thailand, the United States, the United Kingdom, and Vietnam, as well as eminent scientists from the host country. Additionally, it included abstracts from nearly 300 participants from across the country and abroad. A book titled "Practical Biochemistry", authored by Dr. Indu Bhushan was also released by the honorable Minister, Dr.Jitendra Singh, during the event. SMVDU Celebrates Dogri Manyata Divas





Prof. Vishav Murti Shastri, noted Sanskrit scholar and Padamshree awardee while speaking on the occasion exhorted the people of Jammu region to put in all efforts to promote Dogri language, art and culture and preserve the Dogra heritage. "Dogri represents our linguistic identity and we need to make it a part of curriculum from school to university level" he said. Prof. Shiv Nirmohi noted scholar of Dogri culture and Padamshree awardee hailed the contribution of Dogri poets and writers for the recognition of the Dogri language. He emphasized the need for promoting Dogri language and literature among young generation through institutions of learning. Prof. R K Sinha, Vice Chancellor, SMVDU, and Padamshree awardee while speaking on the occasion stressed the need for communicating in our mother tongue. "Unless and until we don't respect our languages we won't be able to respect our culture and civilisation and nation" he said.
