### World Logic Day Celebrated at SMVD University

On 16<sup>th</sup> January 2023, the School of Philosophy & Culture at Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University organized a special lecture to commemorate "World Logic Day", an International Day declared by UNESCO in

association with the International Council for Philosophy and Human Sciences (CIPSH). The Head of the School of Philosophy & Culture, Shri Sumanta Sarathi Sharma, welcomed all guests and participants. The guest speaker, Prof. B. H. Boruah (Dean of International Relations, IIT Jammu), delivered an intriguing lecture on the topic "On Critical Thinking and Logic." His talk shed light on the importance of logic and its relevance in everyday life, in his words, "no one can run away from logic." He discussed various aspects related to logic, such as the relationship between logic and ontology, logical and analytical truths, and the status of the empty domain and the conceptual truths. Prof. Boruah emphasized the interrelationship of logic with other fields of study like physics and mathematics, stat-



ing that pure mathematics cannot be thought of without logic. He defined logic as a study of certain mathematical properties of certain artificial formal languages, valid inference, and certain unique truths or facts. Prof. Boruah also explained some of the debatable topics in logic, such as the debatable nature of some of the logical principles and the variations in their application in different contexts. The lecture was highly informative and engaging and was followed by a Q&A session where participants had the opportunity to interact with the speaker and clarify their doubts. The event was a great success and provided valuable insights into the importance of logic in our lives.


# **Publication/Paper Presented**

#### **SMVDU Scholar Awarded ICSSR Doctoral Fellowship**

Tapas Sudan, a researcher at Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, has been awarded the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) Doctoral Fellowship, a Centrally Administered Fellowship, for a period of two years. He will work on his Ph.D. thesis titled "Mitigation Strategies Adopted to Combat Unprecedented Supply Chain Disruptions: The Case of Indian Manufacturing Industry" under the supervision of Dr. Rashi Taggar, Faculty at the School of Business. Out of 461 students, 28 students from Jammu and Kashmir were awarded the fellowship. Tapas Sudan has also received funding from the Asian Development Bank (Tokyo) for his research on "Recovering Supply Chain Disruptions in the



dia's Experiences and Policy Options", which he co-authored with his supervisor. He has published research papers in national and international journals and edited volumes and has participated in national and international conferences related to supply chain management and other allied management aspects.

### **Best Paper Award to SMVDU Scholar**

Shahbaz Indu, a research scholar at the School of Business, received the Best Paper Award in the Marketing track at the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on Changing Business Paradigm (ICCBP) held at the

Management Development Institute (MDI) Murshidabad in January 2023. The theme of the conference was "Reinventing Marketing through Sustainability, Innovation, and Analytics". Shahbaz's paper, titled "What Determines the Purchase of Superfoods? An Empirical Assessment of Indian Consumer", explores the factors influencing the purchase of superfoods among Indian consumers. The paper also discusses the inclusion of superfoods in dietary plans. The conference included researchers from India, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Spain, China, Ghana, and the USA, who presented their research work through online and offline modes. The submitted paper has been accepted



for publication in the book by Bloomsbury India. Shahbaz is pursuing his research under the guidance of Dr. Rashi Taggar. The event was a great opportunity for researchers to share their findings and discuss current trends in marketing.
