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Governor N. N. Vohra, Chancellor of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, inaugurated two new blocks of Basohli Boys Hostel to meet the fast growing requirements of residential accommodation for the increasing number of students every year. This 5-storey Hostel Blocks, with a built up area of 1,44,000 sft, have been constructed by the University Engineering Wing at an estimated cost of Rs. 25.50 crore. The two Blocks have accommodation for 396 students and will augment the accommodation facilities in a big way for the increasing number of students in this University. It is pertinent to recall that the existing two Hostel Blocks have accommodation for 150 students. With the addition of two new blocks to the Basohli Boys Hostel, the total hostel accommodation in this fully residential University would now accommodate around 2000 students. The Governor went around the Hostel Blocks and viewed the facilities provided in the dining hall, cafeteria, first-aid room, recreation hall and various rooms. He laid special emphasis on the steady growth of the University, while ensuring a high quality of teaching, training and research programmes. The Governor was informed that a 3-storey Girls Hostel building with a built up area of 1,20,000 sft is coming up in the campus which will be completed by January 2018 at an estimated cost of Rs. 36.25 crore having accommodation facilities for 418 students. With the completion of this hostel building, the total accommo-

dation facilities will go up to provide for about 2400 students. The Governor also flagged off the 'Initiative Towards Green Campus' with 6 girl students taking off on a tour of the Campus on bicycles, to enlarge awareness among all the stakeholders to reduce vehicular movements to the bare minimum. The Governor interacted with the students associated with this initiative and lauded this effort. He also planted a sapling of Rudraksha in the Hostel premises on this occasion. Prof. Sanjeev



Jain, Vice Chancellor, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, presented to the Governor the details of the facilities made available for the hostel inmates. Prof. Jain also gave details of various ongoing infrastructure development works in the varsity. H. L. Maini, Member Shrine Board; Jitendra Kumar Singh, Chief Executive Officer, SMVDSB; Prasanna Ramaswamy G, Deputy Commissioner, Reasi; Dr. M. K. 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Holistic Program on Yoga



She also discussed the scope of various Scholarship schemes available for Faculty, research scholars, UG/PG students and organization of short term training programs for acquiring skill sets and hands-on training at all levels. She concluded by informing the audience present that their Department can help scientists to do research and make significant contributions to basic science and development of science in the nation! Prof. V. Verma, Head, Department of Biotechnology & Dean, Faculty of Engineering extended a vote of thanks to Dr. Meenakshi Munshi for sparing time to visit SMVDU and deliver such an exciting & interactive talk. The Lecture was attended by the Faculty members, research scholars and UG/PG students of the DoBT & faculty of other departments of SMVDU. Dr. Meenakshi also emphasized on the futuristic approach for encouraging young researchers to explore the highly lucrative and attractive R&D funding opportunities available in India. She also visited all the labs of the Department accompanied by Prof. V. Verma, and Dr. Sharada M. Potukuchi, Associate Prof. & Academic Coordinator, DoBT.

Faculty Update

Dr. Balbir Singh completes Six Sigma Green Belt Certification

Dr. Balbir Singh, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Mechanical Engineering completed his Six Sigma Green Belt Certi-

fication from Indian Statistical Institute, New Delhi. Dr. Singh is also qualified as an internal auditor for the IS/ ISO 9001:2015, IS/ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 18001:2007 Standards. Six Sigma is a quality improvement approach used to bring down defects level to 3.4 parts per million opportunities. Dr. Singh is planning to work for the improvement of quality level in local industries through MSME cluster and Industry-Academia association (IAC). First IAC-2017 was held in SMVDU in March 2017 and now planning for 2nd IAC in December 2017 wherein industrialists and academicians can jointly explore areas to work on issues faced by industries. The objective of this association is to work jointly in getting national and international recognition such as ZED (zero defects and zero effect), Six Sigma etc. by state industries. To further support industries, labs in the Engineering Department of SMVDU are fully equipped with production based machines and testing facilities which can be accessed by industries.



Ar. Navin Gupta, Assistant Professor in School of Architecture and Landscape Design presented research paper on "Sustainable

landscapes in context to Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University" at First International Conference on the topic "Sustainability, Art & Culture" organized by Warmadeva University, Bali, Indonesia. The main theme of the conference was related to Architecture & Civil Engineering. As such more than 50 delegates from all across the world deliberated in the event. Subsequently, need to establish a path-breaking sustainable practice with examples is proposed other than just emphasizing on sustainability as just a matter of 'FAD'. Ar. Anoop Sharma also presented one research paper in one of the technical session of the conference on the topic, "Legibility of contemporary building in India amid cultural/



The multi-server queuing model considered in this paper can be used for modelling the computer-communication systems incorporating congestion control mechanism and having packet loss due to time-out mechanism. This paper is accepted for publication in the "Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS)" a Springer series in-

dexed by Scopus and ISI Conference Proceedings Citation index (Thomson Reuters). This research visit was funded under Professional Development Assistance (PDA) scheme of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, Katra.
