SMVDU Organises Heritage Walk at Babore Temples, Manwal



The historic Babore temples at Manwal on Friday witnessed a huge gathering of historians, academicians, artists and students to celebrate Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav by a collaborative venture of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University (SMVDU), Surinsar Mansar Development Authority and Directorate of Tourism. The two schools of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, namely School of Architecture and Landscape Design (SoALD) & School of Philosophy and Culture (SoPC) also participated in the event. In that, a Heritage Walk was flagged-off by CEO, Surinsar-Mansar Development Authority, Dr. Gurwinder Jeet Singh, that covered five temple sites spread over one kilometre. During the walk, visitors were informed about the prominent historical, architectural and cultural aspects of the sites at Manwal that are being maintained by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). Eminent expert from Archaeological Survey of India, Jammu Chapter, Asst. Archaeologist, Mr. Jai Karan Singh briefed everyone about the historic essence and architectural grandeur of the temples, namely, Devi Bhagwati Temple, Dera Babore, Kala Dera 1 and 2. They captured the temples through photographs, videos, sketching. SMVDU Organises Heritage Walk at Krimchi Temple Complex



Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University in collaboration with Patnitop Development Authority and Archaeological Survey of India organized a heritage walk at the historic Krimchi Temple Complex, Udhampur. Held under the aegis of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, the event witnessed an enthusiastic gathering of students, historians, artists, administrators, and academicians. The Heritage Walk up to Krimchi Fort was flagged off by Padma Shri Prof. Ravindra Kumar Sinha, VC, SMVDU, and Thakur Sher Singh, CEO, PDA, from the Krimchi Temples. During the guided tour followed by Heritage Baithak, the participants were made aware about the prominent historical, architectural and cultural aspects of the sites at Krimchi that are being maintained by Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). The group of ancient temples located at Krimchi, in Udhampur District of Jammu and Kashmir, are believed to have been built around 11th and 12th century AD, and popularly identified as Pandava Temples given their Mahabharat connection. These temples, designed on stone structures, with a stream flowing nearby, take one to the magnificence of bygone era. Jai Karan Singh and other experts from ASI, J&K Circle, briefed about the historic essence and architectural grandeur of the temples. Anil Paba and Ashok Sharma, Heritage Experts, provided a detailed insight to the rich and royal past of Jammu region, and emphasized the importance of preserving it for the posterity. The VC, SMVDU appreciated the initiative undertaken by the University amidst the growing need for exposure to local heritage and culture, especially for students. He said that more such events be organised and that the university should work upon documentation, beautification and preservation of heritage of the region. 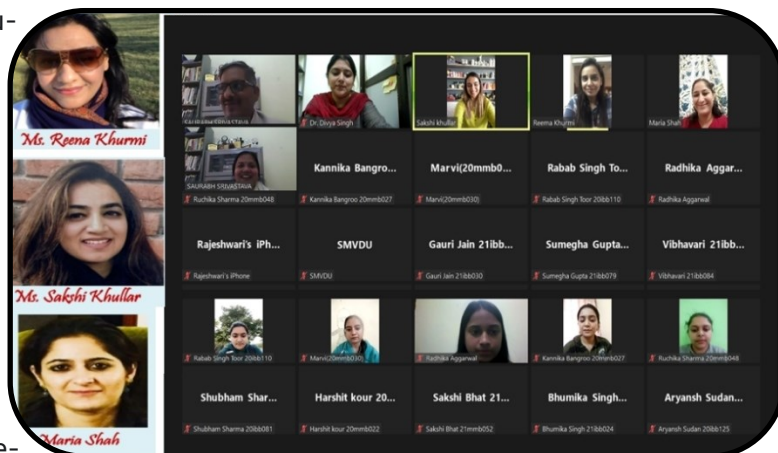
Seminar on “Industry Readiness- Post Covid Scenario: An Alumni Perspective”

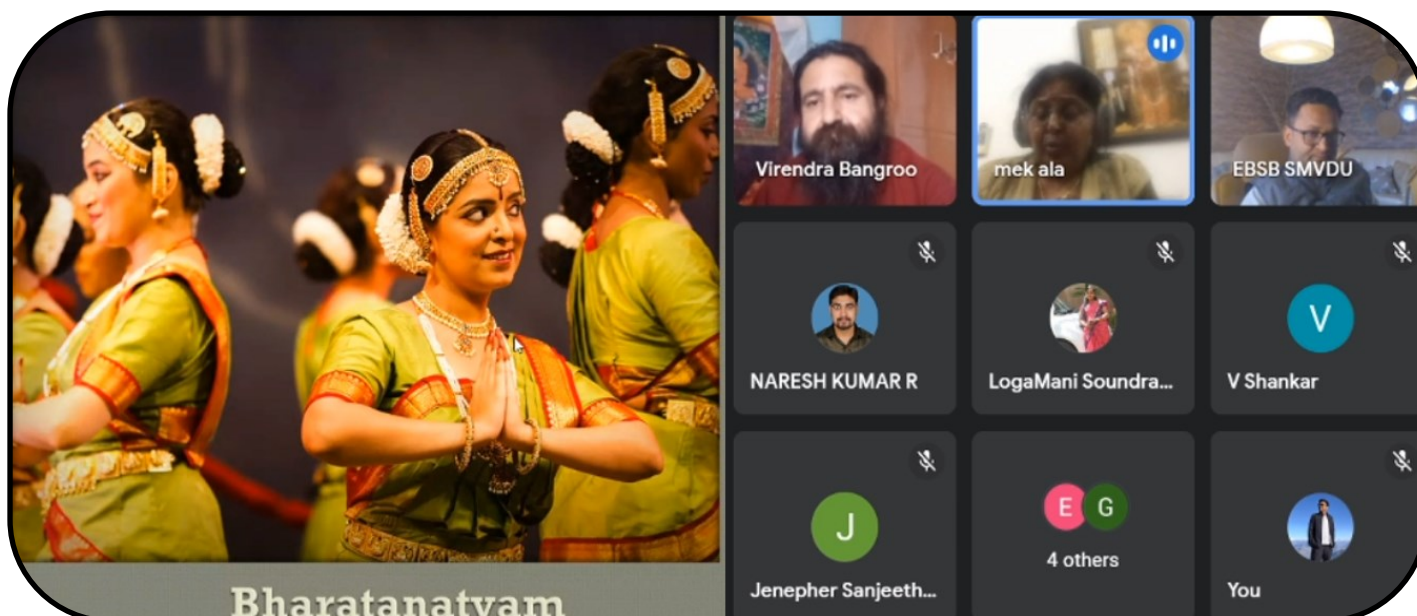


SMVDU Organizes Webinar on Women Entrepreneurship

Vikalp SMVDU Conducted a Village Contact Program

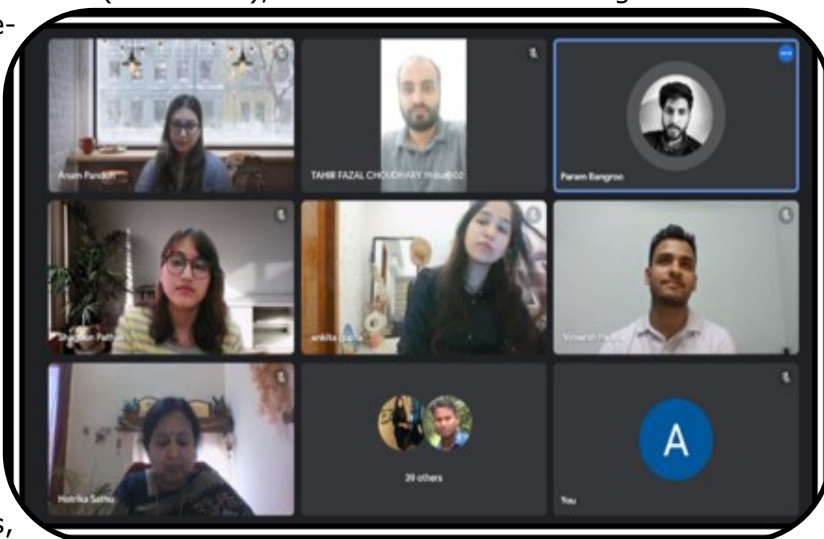
