Agenda Item No.22.1 **Welcoming new member of Academic Council in the 22nd Meeting of Academic Council**

3.1.1 Hon'ble Vice Chancellor introduced and accorded a warm welcome to Prof. Manoj Kumar Panda, Director, Institute of Economic Growth, University of Delhi before the Academic Council.

Agenda Item No.22.2 **Confirmation of the Minutes of the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively.**

3.2.1 The Council confirmed the minutes of the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively.

Agenda Item No.22.3 **Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively.**

3.3.1 The Council noted the action taken by the University on the decisions/recommendations of the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively. It was however, advised by the External Expert Members of Academic Council regarding the following:

3.3.1.1 Regarding adoption of New IPR policy, it was informed that at IIT Delhi for purpose of checking of Plagiarism of Ph.D., M.Tech. & B.Tech. Projects/Theses submitted by the

students, a software named "TURNITIN" is being used. The advantage of this software is that besides checking the Plagiarism it also provides a certification to the effect in favour of student concerned providing clearance over the matter and that the student concerned takes a print out of the same and puts it in his/her Projects/Theses for records. The Librarian, SMVDU informed that SMVD University also uses a software namely "I-Thenticate" for purpose of checking of Plagiarism of the Ph.D. Thesis submitted by the research scholars. However, there is no provision inherent in the software for printing of a certificate to this effect. Besides the software currently in use at SMVDU doesn't provide for checking of Plagiarism of M.Tech./B.Tech. Projects/Theses. The Librarian was asked to examine the matter in the light of the information provided.

3.3.1.2

The provision approved by the Academic Council in its last meeting pertaining to Scheme for Improvement in Grade(s) obtained by students in various courses, that the students who wish to avail the scheme of improvement should be required to attend the classes compulsorily for which improvement in Grade(s) is being sought by the student concerned. This was endorsed by the Academic council.

Consideration of revised curricula of the various UG/PG programs as submitted by the concerned School Directors

3.4.1.1

The revised curricula of the various UG/PG programs as prepared by the concerned School Directors of the various Schools and approved by BPGS & BUGS was presented before the Academic Council. The Academic Council after deliberating upon the matter resolved to accord in-principle approval for applying the revised curricula with the rider that the curricula should also include a few environmental courses for Environmental awareness among the students and also due to the reason that UGC has also desired to include Environment study in course curriculum by institutions imparting higher studies besides being an important topic in our day to day activities. It was desired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor that before finalizing the revised curricula of the various courses the concerned School Directors shall discuss and get the same

examined quickly with the concerned subject experts and External Members of the Academic Council.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.2 **Considering proposal for Starting of new School viz. School of Economics under Faculty of Management.**

3.4.2.1

The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the BPGS & BUGS for starting of a new School viz. School of Economics under Faculty of Management and recommended the creation of following 16 Faculty positions (besides the ones already in place) for the School of Economics, which however shall be filled in a phased manner of 03⁺ Faculty positions every successive year.

3.4.2.2

The member Academic Council Prof. Sunil Kale, however clarified before the house that the Five Years Integrated M.Sc. (Economics) Program started recently by the University cannot be termed as a Dual Degree Program since it has no exit option and therefore the program is integrated in One Degree only. Therefore the appropriate terminology of the program should be "Five Years Integrated M.Sc. (Economics) Program".

3.4.2.3

The Academic Council also considered the recommendations of the BPGS & BUGS that 03 Faculty Members of School of Computer Science & Engineering having MCA qualification, and other faculty members who are appointed in future for the MCA programme, need to be included within the purview of "Faculty of Sciences" and that the program of MCA being offered by School of Computer Science & Engineering needs to be governed by UGC Regulations 2010 pertaining to Faculty of Sciences and not the Faculty of Engineering and therefore for all administrative matters, these 03 Faculty Members shall be reporting to Dean, Faculty of Sciences through Director School of Computer Science & Engineering.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.3 **Consideration of Finalization of 10 years Perspective Plan.**

3.4.3.1

The 10 years Perspective Plan for the period 2015-2025 as discussed and approved by BPGS & BUGS was presented before

the Academic Council. Each of the concerned School Director presented the perspective plan of their concerning School(s). While according an in-principle approval to the perspective plan by the Academic Council and appreciating the task / exercise carried by the University, the following suggestions were made by the External Experts Members of the Academic council:

- 3.4.3.1.1 Increasing the number of PDF in School of Energy Management due to reason being that it is primarily a research based School.
- 3.4.3.1.2 Introduction/addition of new courses such as "Sewerage" etc. in the academic curriculum of School of Architecture & Landscape Design.
- 3.4.3.1.3 Providing of complete details in the perspective plan concerning School of languages & literature by the Director concerned.
- 3.4.3.1.4 The Introduction of School of Education by the University was again reemphasized by the Academic Council for which the Academic Council has accorded approval. Prof. Ratnamala Chatterjee informed that the School of Education and Home Science of University of Aurangabad has been a very successful venture both in terms of Academic and Financial outcomes and the courses offered by the School are the most sought after courses at the University of Aurangabad.

Re-considering the number of Fellowships/Assistantships to Research Scholars in each School.

- 3.4.4.1 The Academic Council considered the proposal for limiting the number of Fellowships/Assistantships to Research Scholars in each School and approved the recommendations of BPGS & BUGS that each eligible Faculty Member as Ph.D. guide shall have under his supervision a maximum of one Ph.D. Research Scholar who is receiving Assistantship either from the University resources or from any other external source. Only after successful completion of the Ph.D. research by the scholar concerned and his/her submission of thesis, a fresh allotment of Ph.D. Research Scholar (receiving Assistantship) shall be made in favour of the concerned Faculty member, thereby limiting the no. of Assistantships per faculty member rather than per School. The recommendations shall be submitted to Executive Council for consideration and approval.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.5 **Considering proposal for establishing of UGC Academic Staff College at SMVDU as per UGC guidelines.**

3.4.5.1 The Academic Council approved the proposal as drafted by the Committee as constituted for establishing of UGC Academic Staff College now renamed as Human Resource Development Centre at SMVDU for onward submission to UGC.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.6 **Process of admission for NRI/ Foreign seats allocated to the various degree programs at SMVDU including the fee to be charged and the mode of admission for these seats.**

3.4.6.1 The Academic Council considered and approved the recommendations of the Deans Committee w.r.t. the process of admission for NRI/ Foreign seats allocated to the various degree programs at SMVDU as under:

3.4.6.1.1 10% of the total no. of seats in a particular programme of study shall be filled in addition to the approved no. of seats of that program for NRI/Foreign students.

3.4.6.1.2 Mode of Selection: The admission be based on the merit of the student in qualifying exams e.g., for UG admission rank of the student in JEE/SAT or any other national/international level exam recognized by AIU for admission in such course in the country; for PG admission similarly the student should have qualified GATE/CAT/MAT/C-MAT/JAM/ /XAT/JMAT/ SNAP / GRE / GMAT or any other equivalent exam of the national/international level of the country.

3.4.6.1.3 An amount of US\$ 6000 per annum and US\$ 3000 for the last odd semester shall be charged towards Tuition Fee for all the UG, PG and Dual Degree programmes offered by the University. Other components of the fee structure will remain the same as for all other students.

The recommendations shall be submitted to Executive Council for consideration and approval.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.7 **Considering proposal for establishing of Nano-Technology Cell at SMVDU and resubmitting Proposal to DST, GOI, New Delhi for Starting 'Centre for Nano-Technology' at SMVDU**

3.4.7.1 The Academic Council approved the proposal for establishing of Nano-Technology Cell at SMVDU. It was also decided re-submit its proposal to Govt. of India for starting "Centre for Nano-Technology" at SMVDU. However, Prof. Ratnamala Chatterjee apprised that for the funding of such projects, the newly set up Department of Electronics & IT, Government of India may also be approached.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.8 **Consideration of recommendations of Board of Studies of SBT for renaming B.Tech. (IBT) program as B.Tech. (BT) and Modifications in the Admission Procedure.**

3.4.8.1 The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the Board of Studies of SBT for renaming B.Tech. (IBT) program as B.Tech. (BT) and Modifying the Admission Procedure for filling up the seats whereby students with minimum of 60% marks in senior secondary (10+2) examination with Biology as one of the subjects shall be admitted directly on the basis of merit as per this qualifying examination and that the present admission procedure for filling up the seats of B.Tech. (IBT) through JEE (mains) process shall be discontinued subject to applicable regulatory system. The recommendations of the Academic Council shall be submitted to Executive Council for consideration and approval.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.9 **Considering the Proposal of Additional Security Deposit (ASD) as rider and Discouragement on the University Assistantship Recipient Full-time Research Scholars from Discontinuing Ph.D. Program.**

3.4.9.1 The Academic Council appreciated and approved the proposal of putting a rider in the form of Additional Security Deposit (ASD) for retaining half the amount of monthly Assistantship payable to the Research Scholars upto the period he/she clears the Oral Comprehensive examination along with approval of the Research plan and for releasing this amount subsequently to the respective Research Scholar upon the submission of his/her thesis. This would not only safeguard the interest of the University in terms of preventing loss of faculty time as well as University resources but also deter the concerned Research Scholars from discontinuing and leaving the Ph.D. program mid-way.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.10 **Constituting of the Board of Academics, Research and Consultancy (BARC) by amalgamating both BPGS & BUGS.**

3.4.10.1 The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the BPGS & BUGS for constituting by the "Board of Academics, Research and Consultancy" (BARC) by combining Board for Post Graduate Studies (BPGS) & the Board for Under Graduate Studies (BUGS) and including monitoring of R&D and consultancy activities under BARC. The composition of this Board will be on the same lines as those for constitution of BPGS & / or BUGS, i.e. one representative from each School of Study. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor will be the Chairman of BARC (until there is adequate faculty at senior level to be nominated as Chairman) and one of the Deans of Faculties to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor as the Vice Chairman of BARC. The Vice Chancellor may nominate a few more members to BARC in view of the Research & Consultancy functions' addition in the domain of activities of the new Board.

Agenda Item No.22.5

Consideration of approval for Award of Ph.D. Degree to 06 Research Scholars and to the students of B.Tech. (Electronics & Communication Engineering), B.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering), B.Tech. (Computer Science & Engineering), B.Tech. (Industrial Biotechnology), B.Arch., MBA, MBA (BE), M.Tech. (CSE), M.Tech. (ECE), M.Sc. (Mathematics), M.Sc. (Physics), M.Sc. (Biotechnology), M.A. (English) and M.A. (Philosophy) who have qualified for the award of respective degrees, during the Academic Session 2013-14.

3.5.1 The Academic Council recommended to the Executive Council the award of degrees in respective programs to the qualified students of the following batches including the 06 nos. of research scholars for award of Ph.D. Degree.

- 3.6.1 The Academic Council considering the request of the student recommended to the Executive Council for approving the issuance of Duplicate Degree of B.Arch. program in favor of Ms. Saakshi Terway (2007EAL05), a pass out student of B.Arch. programme Session 2012-13 with requisite fee of Rs. 3,000/-.

Consideration of approval for the inclusion of Mother's name in the Academic Qualification and Related Certificates issued by the University such as Provisional Certificate, Migration Certificate, Degree etc.

- 3.7.1 The Academic Council approved the inclusion of Mother's name in the format of Academic Qualification and Related Certificates being issued by the University to the students such as Provisional Certificate, Migration Certificate, Degree etc. However, the name and surname of the student shall be recorded on certificates/testimonials in exactly the same manner as given in the Secondary / Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate issued by the recognised concerned authority.

Consideration of Recommendations of Board of Studies of School of Biotechnology.

- 3.8.1 The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the Board of Studies of School of Biotechnology as under:

- i.) Subject areas for curriculum development of B.Tech., M.Sc. and Ph.D. programs being offered by SBT.
- ii.) Renaming of B.Tech. (Industrial Biotechnology) program to B.Tech. (Biotechnology) program (also considered and approved at Agenda Item No. 22.4.8).
- iii.) Modification in course structure and contents of B.Tech.(IBT), M.Sc.(Biotechnology), Ph.D. (Biotechnology) and Ph.D.(Chemistry).
- iv.) Recommendations for inclusion of Dr. S. Subramanian, Principal Scientist, IARI, New Delhi and Dr. Qazi Parvaiz Hassan, Scientist, IJIM, Jammu as Co-Supervisors in SBT was approved by the Academic Council. It was however observed that inclusion/recognition of Co-Supervisors should be decided and finalized in the meeting of School's Academic Affairs Committee and its recommendations should be put up before BPGS (in future, BARC) for approval and the matter be put up before the Academic Council for information only.

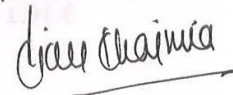

- 3.1.1 Hon'ble Vice Chancellor introduced and accorded a warm welcome to Prof. Manoj Kumar Panda, Director, Institute of Economic Growth, University of Delhi before the Academic Council.

Agenda Item No.22.2 **Confirmation of the Minutes of the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively.**

- 3.2.1 The Council confirmed the minutes of the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively.

Agenda Item No.22.3 **Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively.**

- 3.3.1 The Council noted the action taken by the University on the decisions/recommendations of the 20th & 21st meetings of the Academic Council held on 14/09/2013 & 19/03/2014 respectively. It was however, advised by the External Expert Members of Academic Council regarding the following:

- 3.3.1.1 Regarding adoption of New IPR policy, it was informed that at IIT Delhi for purpose of checking of Plagiarism of Ph.D., M.Tech. & B.Tech. Projects/Theses submitted by the

students, a software named "TURNITIN" is being used. The advantage of this software is that besides checking the Plagiarism it also provides a certification to the effect in favour of student concerned providing clearance over the matter and that the student concerned takes a print out of the same and puts it in his/her Projects/Theses for records. The Librarian, SMVDU informed that SMVD University also uses a software namely "I-Thenticate" for purpose of checking of Plagiarism of the Ph.D. Thesis submitted by the research scholars. However, there is no provision inherent in the software for printing of a certificate to this effect. Besides the software currently in use at SMVDU doesn't provide for checking of Plagiarism of M.Tech./B.Tech. Projects/Theses. The Librarian was asked to examine the matter in the light of the information provided.

3.3.1.2 The provision approved by the Academic Council in its last meeting pertaining to Scheme for Improvement in Grade(s) obtained by students in various courses, that the students who wish to avail the scheme of improvement should be required to attend the classes compulsorily for which improvement in Grade(s) is being sought by the student concerned. This was endorsed by the Academic council.

Agenda Item No.22.4 **Consideration of the recommendations of the Board of Under-Graduate Studies (BUGS) and Board of Post-Graduate Studies (BPGS) in the joint meeting held on 15/09/2014 and upon being adjourned and having concluded on 25/09/2014.**

Agenda Item No. 22.4.1 **Consideration of revised curricula of the various UG/PG programs as submitted by the concerned School Directors**

3.4.1.1 The revised curricula of the various UG/PG programs as prepared by the concerned School Directors of the various Schools and approved by BPGS & BUGS was presented before the Academic Council. The Academic Council after deliberating upon the matter resolved to accord in-principle approval for applying the revised curricula with the rider that the curricula should also include a few environmental courses for Environmental awareness among the students and also due to the reason that UGC has also desired to include Environment study in course curriculum by institutions imparting higher studies besides being an important topic in our day to day activities. It was desired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor that before finalizing the revised curricula of the various courses the concerned School Directors shall discuss and get the same

examined quickly with the concerned subject experts and External Members of the Academic Council.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.2 **Considering proposal for Starting of new School viz. School of Economics under Faculty of Management.**

3.4.2.1

The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the BPGS & BUGS for starting of a new School viz. School of Economics under Faculty of Management and recommended the creation of following 16 Faculty positions (besides the ones already in place) for the School of Economics, which however shall be filled in a phased manner of 03+ Faculty positions every successive year.

The member Academic Council Prof. Sunil Kale, however clarified before the house that the Five Years Integrated M.Sc. (Economics) Program started recently by the University cannot be termed as a Dual Degree Program since it has no exit option and therefore the program is integrated in One Degree only. Therefore the appropriate terminology of the program should be "**Five Years Integrated M.Sc. (Economics) Program**".

3.4.2.3

The Academic Council also considered the recommendations of the BPGS & BUGS that 03 Faculty Members of School of Computer Science & Engineering having MCA qualification, and other faculty members who are appointed in future for the MCA programme, need to be included within the purview of "Faculty of Sciences" and that the program of MCA being offered by School of Computer Science & Engineering needs to be governed by UGC Regulations 2010 pertaining to Faculty of Sciences and not the Faculty of Engineering and therefore for all administrative matters, these 03 Faculty Members shall be reporting to Dean, Faculty of Sciences through Director School of Computer Science & Engineering.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.3 **Consideration of Finalization of 10 years Perspective Plan.**

3.4.3.1

The 10 years Perspective Plan for the period 2015-2025 as discussed and approved by BPGS & BUGS was presented before

the Academic Council. Each of the concerned School Director presented the perspective plan of their concerning School(s). While according an in-principle approval to the perspective plan by the Academic Council and appreciating the task / exercise carried by the University, the following suggestions were made by the External Experts Members of the Academic council:

- 3.4.3.1.1 Increasing the number of PDF in School of Energy Management due to reason being that it is primarily a research based School.
- 3.4.3.1.2 Introduction/addition of new courses such as "Sewerage" etc. in the academic curriculum of School of Architecture & Landscape Design.
- 3.4.3.1.3 Providing of complete details in the perspective plan concerning School of languages & literature by the Director concerned.
- 3.4.3.1.4 The Introduction of School of Education by the University was again reemphasized by the Academic Council for which the Academic Council has accorded approval. Prof. Ratnamala Chatterjee informed, that the School of Education and Home Science of University of Aurangabad has been a very successful venture both in terms of Academic and Financial outcomes and the courses offered by the School are the most sought after courses at the University of Aurangabad.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.4 **Re-considering the number of Fellowships/Assistantships to Research Scholars in each School.**

- 3.4.4.1 The Academic Council considered the proposal for limiting the number of Fellowships/Assistantships to Research Scholars in each School and approved the recommendations of BPGS & BUGS that each eligible Faculty Member as Ph.D. guide shall have under his supervision a maximum of one Ph.D. Research Scholar who is receiving Assistantship either from the University resources or from any other external source. Only after successful completion of the Ph.D. research by the scholar concerned and his/her submission of thesis, a fresh allotment of Ph.D. Research Scholar (receiving Assistantship) shall be made in favour of the concerned Faculty member, thereby limiting the no. of Assistantships per faculty member rather than per School. The recommendations shall be submitted to Executive Council for consideration and approval.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.5 **Considering proposal for establishing of UGC Academic Staff College at SMVDU as per UGC guidelines.**

- 3.4.5.1 The Academic Council approved the proposal as drafted by the Committee as constituted for establishing of UGC Academic Staff College now renamed as Human Resource Development Centre at SMVDU for onward submission to UGC.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.6 **Process of admission for NRI/ Foreign seats allocated to the various degree programs at SMVDU including the fee to be charged and the mode of admission for these seats.**

- 3.4.6.1 The Academic Council considered and approved the recommendations of the Deans Committee w.r.t. the process of admission for NRI/ Foreign seats allocated to the various degree programs at SMVDU as under:

- 3.4.6.1.1 10% of the total no. of seats in a particular programme of study shall be filled in addition to the approved no. of seats of that program for NRI/Foreign students.

- 3.4.6.1.2 Mode of Selection: The admission be based on the merit of the student in qualifying exams e.g., for UG admission rank of the student in JEE/SAT or any other national/international level exam recognized by AIU for admission in such course in the country; for PG admission similarly the student should have qualified GATE/CAT/MAT/C-MAT/JAM/ /XAT/JMAT/ SNAP / GRE / GMAT or any other equivalent exam of the national/international level of the country.

- 3.4.6.1.3 An amount of US\$ 6000 per annum and US\$ 3000 for the last odd semester shall be charged towards Tuition Fee for all the UG, PG and Dual Degree programmes offered by the University. Other components of the fee structure will remain the same as for all other students.

The recommendations shall be submitted to Executive Council for consideration and approval.



Agenda Item No. 22.4.7 **Considering proposal for establishing of Nano-Technology Cell at SMVDU and resubmitting Proposal to DST, GOI, New Delhi for Starting 'Centre for Nano-Technology' at SMVDU**

3.4.7.1 The Academic Council approved the proposal for establishing of Nano-Technology Cell at SMVDU. It was also decided re-submit its proposal to Govt. of India for starting "Centre for Nano-Technology" at SMVDU. However, Prof. Ratnamala Chatterjee apprised that for the funding of such projects, the newly set up Department of Electronics & IT, Government of India may also be approached.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.8 **Consideration of recommendations of Board of Studies of SBT for renaming B.Tech. (IBT) program as B.Tech. (BT) and Modifications in the Admission Procedure.**

3.4.8.1 The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the Board of Studies of SBT for renaming B.Tech. (IBT) program as B.Tech. (BT) and Modifying the Admission Procedure for filling up the seats whereby students with minimum of 60% marks in senior secondary (10+2) examination with Biology as one of the subjects shall be admitted directly on the basis of merit as per this qualifying examination and that the present admission procedure for filling up the seats of B.Tech. (IBT) through JEE (mains) process shall be discontinued subject to applicable regulatory system. The recommendations of the Academic Council shall be submitted to Executive Council for consideration and approval.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.9 **Considering the Proposal of Additional Security Deposit (ASD) as rider and Discouragement on the University Assistantship Recipient Full-time Research Scholars from Discontinuing Ph.D. Program.**

3.4.9.1 The Academic Council appreciated and approved the proposal of putting a rider in the form of Additional Security Deposit (ASD) for retaining half the amount of monthly Assistantship payable to the Research Scholars upto the period he/she clears the Oral Comprehensive examination along with approval of the Research plan and for releasing this amount subsequently to the respective Research Scholar upon the submission of his/her thesis. This would not only safeguard the interest of the University in terms of preventing loss of faculty time as well as University resources but also deter the concerned Research Scholars from discontinuing and leaving the Ph.D. program mid-way.

Agenda Item No. 22.4.10 **Constituting of the Board of Academics, Research and Consultancy (BARC) by amalgamating both BPGS & BUGS.**

3.4.10.1 The Academic Council approved the recommendations of the BPGS & BUGS for constituting by the "**Board of Academics, Research and Consultancy**" (BARC) by combining Board for Post Graduate Studies (BPGS) & the Board for Under Graduate Studies (BUGS) and including monitoring of R&D and consultancy activities under BARC. The composition of this Board will be on the same lines as those for constitution of BPGS & / or BUGS, i.e. one representative from each School of Study. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor will be the Chairman of BARC (until there is adequate faculty at senior level to be nominated as Chairman) and one of the Deans of Faculties to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor as the Vice Chairman of BARC. The Vice Chancellor may nominate a few more members to BARC in view of the Research & Consultancy functions' addition in the domain of activities of the new Board.

Agenda Item No.22.5 **Consideration of approval for Award of Ph.D. Degree to 06 Research Scholars and to the students of B.Tech. (Electronics & Communication Engineering), B.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering), B.Tech. (Computer Science & Engineering, B.Tech. (Industrial Biotechnology), B.Arch., MBA, MBA (BE), M.Tech. (CSE), M.Tech. (ECE), M.Sc. (Mathematics), M.Sc. (Physics), M.Sc. (Biotechnology), M.A. (English) and M.A. (Philosophy) who have qualified for the award of respective degrees, during the Academic Session 2013-14.**

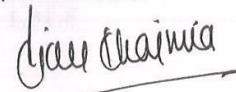
