**1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the BoS held on 28.9.2011**

No observation on the minutes were received, so the minutes were confirmed.

**2. Reporting**

- Mr Deo Prakash, Research Scholar has successfully passed his first Comprehensive exam wherein the Ph.D topic and Research Plan of the candidate are approved. The topic on which the candidate shall pursue his research for Ph.D. is "Optimised Routing and Secure Data Dissemination in Mobile Adhoc Networks"
- Two days workshop was organized by the School on "ERP Mission" Sponsored by MHRD, Delhi, on November 5- 6, 2011 under NMEICT
- In addition the school is regularly organizing technical events for the students such as "Software Freedom Day" where in students from various technical institutions from within and outside J&K are invited to participate.

**3. Agenda Items discussed**

The main agenda items discussed in the fifth meeting of the BoS of the School were regarding the Budget Projections Under XII FY Plan of UGC 2012 – 2017, for the School of Computer Science and Engineering. The Proposed Budget projections were for the Extension in Infrastructure and Academic Development of faculty for enhancement in teaching/ learning process which may be categorized under the following heads:



i. **Development of Centres of Excellence**

The School of CSE is proposing to develop a Centre of Excellence for Cloud Computing in the School. Once the centre is developed, it will provide a tremendous amount of scope in this area for research, MOUs may be signed for collaboration with bigger Software houses so as to share the resources on mutual cooperation basis with them. Faculty Development Programmes, training Programmes and Consultancy services on cloud Computing can be started. The External Expert Member opined that the amount asked for may not be sufficient for setting up the Centre of Excellence. After deliberations, it was decided that the following financial outlay may be needed:

ii. **Development of New Labs**

The School of CSE has started M.Tech/ CSE from the academic session 2011- 12 with an intake of seven students. The candidates with valid GATE score and 60% marks in the qualifying exam are eligible to apply for admission to M.Tech/ CSE. The admission is made by giving 85% weightage to the GATE score and 15% to the Personal Interview. The following Labs are proposed to be developed in a phased manner for M.Tech/ CSE students which shall also enhance the learning process for B.Tech/CSE students. Professor Devanand was of the view that there should be proposal for a Research Lab for the School which was unanimously accepted by all the members. The budget requirements for the development of these labs has been indicated against each lab.

iii. **Development of Computer Centre for the University**

The School of CSE is providing a facility for surfing the Internet through a Broad Band 40 MBPS dedicated connection for all the 1440 students of the university through Internet Lab from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm on all working days and from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm on all Saturdays in addition to the Wi-Fi facility available on the campus. The requirement of this facility shall increase with the increase in number of students on the campus with the start of new courses and increase in the intake of existing courses. The school proposes to cater this need with the development of a Computer Centre for the university with 150 Computer Systems. The financial requirements shall be as under:
