The I/c Head, SOPC welcomed all the present members in the meeting and the following points were discussed.

Agenda Item No. 1: Course structure of the BA Philosophy program.

- 1. A discussion on the course structure of the BA Philosophy program was initiated by the Head, SoPC. It was decided that the below mentioned table be considered from the next academic session for BA Philosophy. The following changes were recommended by BoS:
 - (a) The total credits of the program were increased from 143 to 148.
 - (b) Environmental Science will be offered in the second semester in place of the first semester.
 - (c) DHV is renamed as Discourse on Universal Human Values (II) (LTP structure as 4-0-0) as per the directions of UHV cell and AICTE norms.
 - (d) The LTP structure of the following courses were changed as follows:

 It was further proposed to change the course title of Discourse on Human Virtues to Discourse on Universal Human Values: Understanding Harmony and Ethical Conduct (UHV-II) for all UG/PG/Integrated programs.

3. The BoS deliberated on the admission issues of MA Philosophy and MA Vedic Studies programs. It was proposed that the fee structure of the MA (Philosophy) program shall be made comparable to Jammu University MA (Philosophy) program or may be fully sponsored by SMVD Shrine Board. All members of BoS further agreed that SMVD Shrine Board may provide full sponsorship for MA (Vedic Studies) program.

4. It was also decided to develop new interdisciplinary courses by all faculty members of SoPC in accordance with NEP 2020. Furthermore, old courses such as Philosophy of Science and Cognitive Science may be revised taking into consideration contemporary developments.
