At the onset, Chairman of the Committee welcomed all the members to the meeting and briefed the course structure for Five years integrated program as per details mentioned in the NEP 2020.

After detailed discussion on the matter, following decisions were made:

- A. **Common Course for Each Program of Study:** It was decided that the Heads/ I/c Heads of the following schools shall design the course structure and offer the following common courses for each program of study:

It was also decided that each school shall offer at least one open elective (multidisciplinary) course of 03 credits.

Chairman of the Committee informed that the course code for open elective offered shall be kept same if the course is already being at School level. However, new course code shall be generated if the open elective offered by the school is a new course.

B. Vocational Courses: It was informed to the Committee that as per NEP 2020, Five years Integrated Programs have multiple entry & multiple exit options. A student, who exits the course after one year of study, shall be provided with a Undergraduate Certificate (Field of study/discipline). (Programme duration: First year (first two semesters) of the undergraduate programme, followed by an exit 10-credit bridge course(s) lasting two months, including at least 06-credit job-specific internship/apprenticeship that would help the graduates acquire job-ready competencies required to enter the workforce.

The Chairman of the Committee directed the Heads of the schools to identify 2-3 vocational courses of 04 credits at their school level, so that the same can be offered if the student opts to exit after 01 year of study.

After detailed discussion on the matter some of the Vocational courses identified are mentioned below:

1. Carpentry (SoALD)
2. Welding (SoCE)
3. Lab skills and Live Sciences (SoBT)
4. Ms Excel (SoCSE)
5. Networking (SoCSE)
6. Web Designing (SoCSE)
7. Accounting (SoB)

It was also desired by Chairman of the committee that at least one vocational course shall be offered by each school.

C. Other details regarding five year integrated program: The Committee was also informed about Credit Plan distribution for Integrated Bachelor of Arts/Science/Business (Honours)-in Discipline & Master of Arts/Science/Business in Discipline the details of the same are attached as Annexure A.

It was agreed that all Heads of the schools shall design the course structures of the integrated program(s) as being offered by the respective schools by conducting the meetings of their respective Board of Studies. In the first instance the course structure for first year for the session 2022-23 for the integrated programs shall be designed and implemented.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
