2. Networking (SoCSE)
3. Welding (SoCE)
4. Lab skills and Live Sciences (SOBT)
5. Web Designing (SoCSE)
6. Ms Excel (SoCSE)

It was also desired by Chairman of the committee that at least one vocational course shall be offered by each school.
c. Other details regarding five year integrated program: The Committee was also informed about Credit Plan distribution for Integrated Bachelor of Arts/Science/Business (Honours)-in Discipline \& Master of Arts/Science/Business in Discipline the details of the same are attached as Annexure A.

It was agreed that all Heads of the schools shall design the course structures of the integrated program(s) as being offered by the respective schools by conducting the meetings of their respective Board of Studies. In the first instance the course structure for first year for the session 2022-23 for the integrated programs shall be designed and implemented.
