Hon'ble Vice Chancellor SMVD University accorded a warm welcome to all the members. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor highlighted the achievements of the University in a brief presentation during the past one year and informed the house about the successful conduct of the  $10^{th}$  Convocation conducted by SMVD University on  $15^{th}$  Feb. 2025. It was also informed to the





August House that 35 faculty members (out of 38 selected) have joined SMVD University, at the position of Assistant Professor & Associate Professor, during AY 2024-25.

During the meeting, the August House was informed that as per the direction of Executive Council, the Academic Rules & Regulations, Minimum Standards and Procedures for award of Ph.D. degree regulations, 2022 with amendments in Ph.D. Ordinances of SMVDU and Closure of Schools that have been approved earlier by the Executive Council but yet not operational and Rationalization of faculty strength in the School of Business have been reviewed by the Committee constituted by Executive Council for the purpose and recommendations of the Committee have now been approved by the Hon'ble Chancellor. It was desired that the revised the Academic Rules & Regulations be shared with the Academic Council members.

The Council was also informed that an agenda regarding Closure of schools that were approved earlier by the Executive Council but not yet operational and Rationalization of faculty strength in the School of Business was placed before Executive Council in its 35<sup>th</sup> meeting where by it was resolved that a committee be constituted to take a comprehensive view in respect of the Programs which have not started yet and submit a detailed proposal for rationalization of Schools and introduction of new Schools/ Programs such as Law and Architecture with specialization in Urban & Town Planning, considering the core strength of the University.

Accordingly, the Committee met on 31<sup>st</sup> Dec. 2024 and submitted its recommendations for approval of the Hon'ble Chancellor, SMVDU whereby a new B.Tech. program in Mechatronics was proposed to be started. Also, it was recommended by the Committee that 03 positions of Assistant Professor and 01 position of Associate Professor be relocated from some of the Schools which are not yet functional to meet the initial requirements of the faculty. The recommendations of the Committee have also now been approved by the Hon'ble Chancellor.

The Academic Council deliberated upon the recommendation of Board of Studies meeting of School Mechanical Engineering held on 20<sup>th</sup> Feb., 2025 duly reviewed by Dean, FoE in the above background and was of the opinion that only those courses which address the requirement and evolving needs of current times be started by the concerned Schools and approved the following:

- Starting of B.Tech. 'Robotics & Al' Program with intake of 60 seats instead of 'B.Tech. in Mechatronics' as proposed by BoS of by School of Mechanical Engineering. The program be started with effect from AY 2025-26. The faculty positions as already shifted/ sanctioned for proposed program of 'B.Tech. in Mechatronics' by the statutory authorities of the University shall now be utilized for the new program of B.Tech. 'Robotics & Al' which comprises of 01 position of Associate Professor and 03 Assistant Professors.
- The SoME shall conduct workshop on development of curriculum for Robotics & Al'.

The Academic Council authorized the Vice Chancellor (Chairman, Academic Council) to approve the curriculum based on the recommendations of the workshop.

- **8.** Before granting "Consent of Affiliation" to the College or a Program, the University shall satisfy itself that the proposed institute:
  - i. has all required Academic and Residential moveable/immovable infrastructure as per parameters and norms prescribed by the Regulatory Body i.e. NMC;
  - ii. has sufficient budgetary provisions for the proposed institute or to run the Program;
  - iii. has adequate availability of infrastructure as per Minimum Standard Requirements (MSR) of the NMC for starting of UG(MBBS) Course;
  - iv. has the required number of Teaching Faculty/Non-Teaching staff available for running the College or the Program.
- 9. Governing Body:
  - i. The affiliated institute/college shall have a duly constituted Governing Body by Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board (SMVDSB) with representatives of the teaching staff, to advise the Principal in the internal affairs of the College. A record of proceedings of the said governing body of the



- proposed institute/college shall be maintained by the Principal. Any change in the Governing Body of the College shall be reported to the University immediately.
- ii. The Governing Body of the affiliated institute/college shall meet at least once every three months to consider the budget estimates and such other matters as may arise in its working including consideration of the Annual Report, the audited statement of accounts, changes in the staff, subjects or Programs/examination and fixation of fees etc. A copy of the minutes of the meeting shall also be sent to the Registrar of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, Katra, within 15 days of the meeting.
- 10. All other norms/guidelines as may be prescribed by the NMC from time to time and not covered by these Statutes shall also be fulfilled by the proposed Medical College.

## 11. Interpretation of Statutes:

If any question regarding the interpretation of these Statutes arises, the same shall be referred to the Vice Chancellor, SMVD University for final decision.

Provided further, wherever Statutes governing the Affiliation and Recognition of an affiliated College or a Program started and maintained by the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board are silent on any subject or require any modification/additions or relaxation, the Vice Chancellor, SMVD University may bring the same to the notice of the Executive Council through Academic Council for final decision.

Any amendment/repealing of the existing statutes proposed by the Medical College will be approved by the Executive Council through Academic Council.

## <u>Statutes Governing Admissions, Evaluation, Faculty Selection, and Academics</u> <u>for SMVDIME-Medical College & Associated Hospital</u>

#### 1. Faculty:

A new faculty entitled "Faculty of Medical Sciences" may be created in the University to deal with the academic& research issues pertaining to the discipline of Medical Sciences. The Executive Director/ Principal of SMVDIME-Medical College & Associated Hospital will be the ex-officio Dean of Faculty and member of the Academic Council of SMVDU.

## 2. Mode of admission for SMVDIME-Medical College:

The admission to MBBS program to be offered by SMVDIME-Medical College& Associated Hospital shall be made on the basis of merit secured in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET)-UG a single-level national exam







carried out for medical aspirants and associated national-level counseling.

## 3. Eligibility Criteria:

Eligibility criteria for admission shall be as prescribed by the National Testing Agency (NTA) from time to time.

## Currently

- A. He/ She is an Indian citizen
- B. Age: He/ She has attained or will attain the age of seventeen (17) years as on the 31<sup>st</sup> of December of the year of admission (for both General (UR)/ General (EWS) and SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwBD category students) as per the norms of NMC (https://www.nmc.org.in/).
- C. Candidates obtaining 50% marks in (PCBE) i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology & English (40% marks in case of students belonging to reserved category) in 12<sup>th</sup> Class and must have got a rank in the merit list of NEET (UG)-2024 for admission to MBBS Program.
- D. Candidates who have received education abroad and wish to seek admission in SMVDIME must have obtained 50% marks in (PCBE) i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology & English in 12<sup>th</sup> Class and must have got a rank in the merit list of NEET (UG) for current Academic Year for admission to MBBS Program (their equivalency determined by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as per regulations of the NMC and SMVDIME.
- E. Candidate should be Medically Fit.

#### 4. Reservation:

SMVDIME shall follow the Reservation Policy mandated by the centralized counselling authorities from time to time.

### 5. Norms of approving body:

As the NMC governs all medical colleges in India and is responsible for examining the quality of medical education in India, it was recommended that "All other norms/guidelines as may be prescribed by the NMC from time to time shall be fulfilled by the SMVDIME-Medical College".

#### 6. Seats:

50 for the first batch & subsequently as per approval obtained from NMC.

#### 7. Duration

As per NMC guidelines, the MBBS Program shall comprise four and a half

years, followed by a compulsory rotatory internship of one year.

### 8. Examination Schedule:

The examinations schedule shall be as defined by NMC. At the end of each professional year university examination will be conducted. If any student fails to clear the regular university examination, student will appear in supplementary examination.

#### 9. Fee:

The Annual Fee-structure of MBBS program of the College must be reported to the Executive Council of the University which will contain the component of University Fee. The expenditure incurred on account of conduct of paper settings/ Evaluation/ Board of Studies meeting/ practical's examination/ any other academic activities will have to be borne by the affiliated College. The details of students who have cancelled their admission at the affiliated College must be forwarded to the University for records. Fee refund rules, as prescribed by various regulatory authorities shall apply.

#### 10.Board of Studies:

The Board of Studies of Faculty of Medical Sciences shall be constituted having following members:

2.	Nominee of Vice Chancellor, SMVDU - Member					
3.	O2 Faculty members of SMVDIME- Medical College on a seniority basis by rotation to be nominated by the Dean, Faculty of Medical Sciences		Member			
4.	Two or three External Expert Members*	-	Member Expert (External)			

The Chairman may nominate one of the Faculty Member of the College as the Member Secretary of the Board of Studies. Members at Sr. 3 & 4 shall hold office for a period of three years from the date of their nomination. The constitution of the BOS shall be approved by the Academic Council of the University. A minimum of two meetings of the BoS must be held in an Academic Session. A minimum of 04 members shall form the quorum.

\*The list of a panel of External Experts (As needed) shall be provided by the chairman for approval of the Competent Authority. However, only 2-3 experts, out of the approved panel, can be called for a meeting by the Dean, Faculty of







Medical Sciences, as needed, based on the agenda of the meeting.

#### 11. Academic Calendar:

Dean, Faculty of Medical Sciences, shall propose an Annual Academic Calendar to the Dean (AA) of the university, prior to the commencement of each academic session, which after approval of the competent authority, shall be notified and duly followed without any deviation.

## 12. Methodology for Assigning Entry Number:

A unique Entry Number (8 characters) at the time of joining a program of study and this will remain the main mode of identification of each student.

## 13. Curriculum:

The guidelines of NMC, as amended from time to time, shall be followed for the curriculum for MBBS program. The recommendations of Board of Studies of FoMS w.r.t. curriculum shall be placed before the Academic Council of the University for approval.

### 14. Evaluation Procedure:

Both, internal and external evaluation of the Programs will be done as per the program structure (As per NMC guidelines). The panel of the External Experts/Examiner shall be proposed by the Dean of the Faculty of Medical Sciences and approved by HVC, out of the approved panel of experts as recommended by BoS and approved by the Academic Council. The Dean of Faculty of Medical Sciences (FoMS) will coordinate the process of evaluation by the External Experts/Examiners and make necessary arrangements thereof.

Best practices with reference to the evaluation process, including paper setting, moderation of paper, evaluation of answer sheets (Table marking or otherwise), the conduct of lab examinations, choosing of examiners and paper-setters, maintaining secrecy wherever required, etc., in line with the guidelines of NMC and/or, as approved by the Academic Council of the university, shall be followed.



Since, these certificates are to be issued to all the passing out students, thus in order to streamline the activity of payment of required charges, it is proposed that an amount of Rs 2000/- may be included in the fee component to be paid by the students at the time of admission starting from the Academic Session 2025-26 onwards, so that the above certificates are issued by default to the successfully passing out students in their best interest. The following mechanism is proposed for the award of Credits to Students participating in Sports activities and other co-curricular activities at SMVDU.

## Extra-Curricular Credits (ECC)

Extra-curricular credits (ECC) shall be awarded to students for participating in Sports and other co-curricular activities like NCC/NSS/Community Engagement under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), and University festivals. All undergraduate students of B. Tech and FYUP Programs registered for ECC can earn a maximum of 6 academic credits (180 hours) over four years. The extra credits earned will be counted for the evaluation of CGPA/SGPA of that particular semester or overall CGPA towards theend. A student can claim the award of credits in a particular semester and based on the performance of the student in that particular event a student will be awarded a Grade as per the mechanism to be adopted for evaluating these activities. The grade awarded will count towards the calculation of SGPA/CGPA after comparing the Grades of all other courses and the lower grade obtained in any other course will be replaced by the grade obtained in the Sports/extra-curricular activity. These credits can be earned by participating in sports, cultural activities, University festivals and forum activities, and also Inter university activities in the form of representing the University, etc. at National & International Levels. Hours can be earned by those who participate either as part of the group or individually. Students shall be evaluated based on their participation in voluntary services, performance in games and sports, performance in literary activities, performance in cultural activities and their participation in District/Regional/State/National and International level events. Detailed mechanism will be worked out for the award of credits in consultation with all the stakeholders and a committee will be constituted to look into the draft modalities for the award of extra-curricular activities
