



Sub : Relaxation in B.Arch. Eligibility Criteria for the academic session 2022-2023 – reg.

Dear Sir/Madam,

In view of the threat of Pandemic Covid-19, the Council with the approval of the Central Government, has decided to relax the eligibility for admission to 1st year of 5-year B.Arch. Degree Course as prescribed under Regulation 4(1) of the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations 2020, for the academic session 2022-2023 and the same is stated as under:

"(1) No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics subjects or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject."

"(2) The candidate needs to qualify an aptitude test in architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture."

(The above relaxation shall be valid for the academic session 2022-2023 only, irrespective of the year in which a candidate has passed 10+2 or 10+3 examination.) Further, candidates need to qualify an aptitude test in architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture for admission into 1st year of B.Arch. degree course for the academic session 2022-2023.

The same has been published in the Official Gazette of India on June 30, 2022 and has come into effect from the date of publication in the Gazette. A copy of the said notification is attached herewith.

In view of the above, all the admission authorities, universities and institutions imparting B.Arch. degree course in the country are requested to follow the above eligibility criteria for admission into 1st year of 5-year B.Arch. degree course **for the academic session 2022-2023**

फा. सं. सीए/431/2022/म.स.अ.ए(विनियम).—वास्तुविद् अधिनियम, 1972 (1972 का 20 वां) की धारा 21 के साथ पढ़ी जाने वाली धारा 45 की उपधारा (2) के खंड (ई), (जी), (एच), और (जे) के अंतर्गत प्रदत्त शक्तियों के अनुसार केन्द्रीय सरकार के अनुमोदन से वास्तुकला परिषद् एतद् द्वारा वास्तुकला परिषद् (वास्तुकला शिक्षा के न्यूनतम मानक) विनियम, 2020 जो भारत के राजपत्र के भाग III खण्ड 4 में दिनांक 11 अगस्त, 2020 को प्रकाशित हुए हैं में और संशोधन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित विनियम बनाती है, अर्थात् :-

- (1) इन विनियमों का नाम वास्तुकला परिषद् (वास्तुकला शिक्षा के न्यूनतम मानक) (संशोधन) विनियम, 2022 होगा।
(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तिथि से लागू होंगे तथा केवल अकादमिक सत्र 2022-2023, के लिए एकमुश्त उपाय के रूप में लागू होंगे, जिसके उपरान्त मूल विनियम जो कि 11 अगस्त, 2020 को प्रकाशित हुए हैं लागू हो जायेंगे।
- वास्तुकला परिषद् (वास्तुकला शिक्षा के न्यूनतम मानक) विनियम, 2020 के विनियम 4 के उपविनियम (1) तथा उपविनियम (2) के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित उपविनियम रखे जाएंगे :-
(1) कोई भी अभ्यर्थी जिसने 10+2 परीक्षा प्रणाली में भौतिकी, रसायन शास्त्र तथा गणित विषयों के साथ उत्तीर्ण न की हो अथवा 10+3 डिप्लोमा परीक्षा गणित अनिवार्य विषय के साथ उत्तीर्ण न की हो, को वास्तुकला स्नातक पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश नहीं दिया जायेगा।

- (2) अभ्यर्थी को वास्तुकला में अभिरक्षता परीक्षा जो कि या तो वास्तुकला परिषद द्वारा संचालित "नाटा" या एनटीए द्वारा संचालित "जेईई" उत्तीर्ण करना आवश्यक है।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 30th June, 2022

F. No. CA/431/2022/MSAE(Regulations).—In exercise of powers conferred by clauses (c), (g), (h) and (j) of sub-section (2) of Section 45 read with Section 21 of the Architects Act, 1972 (20 of 1972), the Council of Architecture, with the approval of the Central Government, hereby makes the following Regulations to further amend the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations 2020, the same having been published in the Gazette of India, Part-III-Section-4 dated the 11th August, 2020, namely: -

1. (1) These Regulations may be called the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of this publication in the official Gazette and shall be applicable for the academic session 2022-2023 only as a one-time measure and thereafter the original Regulations as notified in the Gazette on 11.08.2020 shall be in force.
2. In the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 2020, in Regulation 4 for sub-regulation (1) and sub-regulation (2), the following sub-regulations shall be substituted, namely: -

"(1) No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics subjects or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject."

"(2) The candidate needs to qualify an aptitude test in architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture."

Footnote : The principal Regulations were published in the Gazette of India, Part III, Section 4, on 11th August, 2020 and amended on 23.03.2021.

COUNCIL OF ARCHITECTURE

(An statutory body of Govt. of India under the Architects Act, 1972)

MINIMUM STANDARDS OF ARCHITECTURAL EDUCATION, 2008 PRESCRIBED UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE ARCHITECTS ACT, 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 21 of the Architects Act, 1972 (20 of 1972), the Council of Architecture hereby makes the following Minimum Standards of Architectural Education supplementing the Council of Architecture (Minimum Standards of Architectural Education) Regulations, 1983, namely:-

1. Short Title and Commencement

- (1) These standards may be called the Council of Architecture - Minimum Standards of Architectural Education, 2008.

2. Duration and Stages of the Course

- (1) The architecture course shall be of minimum duration of 5 academic years / 10 semesters of approximately 18 working weeks each inclusive of one year of practical training after the first stage in a professional's office.
- (2) The 5 years Bachelor's Degree Course in Architecture may be conducted in two stages.
- (3) The First stage of the course shall be the first 3 academic years or 6 semesters (each of approximately 18 working weeks) of institutional academic studies. The First stage shall be completed within 5 years of admission to the B.Arch. Course.
- (4) The Second stage of the course shall be of 2 academic years/ 4 semesters including one year of practical training.
- (5) Registration under the Architects Act, 1972, is acceptable only after successful completion of both the stages.

3. Admission to the Architecture Course

- (1) The Institutions shall admit only such students who have qualified in an Aptitude Test in Architecture.
- (2) The Institutions/ Competent Admission Authorities dealing with admission of candidates to the 1st year of 5-year B.Arch. Degree course are required to follow the admission norms of the Council which is placed at Appendix-A.
- (3) The institutions shall not give weightage of more than 50% marks of Aptitude Test in Architecture in the matter of admissions.

4. Courses and periods of Studies

- (1) The institutions imparting instructions in architecture required for granting recognized qualifications may follow the courses and periods of studies as prescribed in Appendix-A1.
- (2) The Guidelines for Conduct of Architectural Thesis/Project and Practical Training are prescribed in Appendix-A2.

5. Standards of staff, equipment, accommodation, training and other facilities for technical education

- (1) The institutions shall maintain a strength of full time-faculty of 15 (including Principal/HOD) for intake of 40. In addition to the full-time, the visiting faculty will take approximately 25% of the teaching load.
- (2) The institution with the maximum intake of 40 in a class may have the faculty pattern as prescribed in Appendix-B1.
- (3) The Career Advancement Scheme for the faculty has been prescribed in Appendix-B2.

CAREER ADVANCEMENT SCHEME

Incentives for Ph.D. / M.Arch.

- A) At the time of recruitment as Lecturers, four and two advance increments will be admissible to those who hold Ph. D. and M. Arch. Degree respectively.
- B) Two increments will be admissible to those lecturers who acquire M. Arch within four years of recruitment.
- C) A teacher will be eligible for two advance increments as and when he acquires Ph D degree in his service.

Career Advancement

- a) Minimum length of service for eligibility to move into the grade of Lecturer (senior Scale) would be four years for those with Ph D, five years for those with M Arch and six years for others as lecturer.
- b) For eligibility to move into the grade of Lecturer (Selection Grade)/Assistant Professors, the minimum length of service as Lecturer (Senior Scale) shall be uniformly five years.
- c) For movement into grades of Assistant Professor and above, the minimum eligibility criterion would be M. Arch. Those without M. Arch. can go up to the level of Lecturer (Selection Grade).
- d) An Assistant Professor with a minimum of 5 years of service will be eligible for consideration for appointment as Professor.
- e) The selection committees for career advancement shall be the same as those for direct recruitment for each category.

Lecturer (Senior Scale)

A Lecturer will be eligible for placement in a senior scale through a procedure of selection, if she/he has:

- i Completed 6 years of service after regular appointment with relaxation of one year and two years, respectively, for those with M.Arch. and Ph.D.
- ii Participated in Quality Improvement Programs of total duration of 4 weeks or engaged in other appropriate continuing education programs of comparable quality as may be specified or approved by the Council of Architecture. OR accrued 20 credit points through attending or conducting QIP/ Teacher's Training Programs approved by Council of Architecture.
- iii Consistently satisfactory performance appraisal reports.
- iv Shows evidence of serious academic inputs like improved teaching plans, improved teaching methodologies, created innovative teaching aids etc.

Lecturer (Selection Grade)

Lecturers in the Senior Scale who do not have a M. Arch. degree or equivalent published work and who do not meet the scholarship and research standards, but fulfils the other criteria given below for the post of Assistant Professor and have a good record in teaching and preferably have contributed in various ways such as to the corporate life of the institution, examination work or through Research & Extension activities, will be placed in the selection grade subject to the recommendation of the selection committee which is the same as for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor. They will be designated as Lecturers in the Selection Grade. They could offer themselves for fresh assessment after obtaining M. Arch. and/or fulfilling other requirements for promotion as Assistant Professor and if found suitable could be given the designation of Assistant Professor.

Assistant Professor

A Lecturer in the Senior Scale will be eligible for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor if she/he has:

- i Completed 5 years of service in the Senior Scale.
- ii In addition to the sanctioned position of Professors, which must be filled in through direct recruitment through all India advertisements, promotions may be made from the post of Assistant Professor after 5 years of service as Assistant Professor.
- iii Participated in Quality Improvement Programs of total duration of 8 weeks or engaged in other appropriate continuing education programs of comparable quality as may be specified or approved by the Council of

Architecture. OR accrued 40 credit points through attending or conducting QIP/ Teacher's Training Programs approved by Council of Architecture.

Professor

The Selection Committee for promotion to the post of Professor should be the same as that for direct recruitment. For the promotion from Assistant Professor to Professor, the following method of promotion may be followed.

The candidate should present herself/himself before the Selection Committee with the first two and any two of the remaining in the following:

- a. Self-appraisal reports (essential)
- b. Seminars/Conferences attended. Must have attended at least 4 seminars/ conference at national or international level OR must have attended Q.I.P.s (short-term courses) of total duration of 4 weeks.
- c. Research contribution, books, articles, etc. published (At least four papers in Journals are essential). The best three written contributions of the teacher (as defined by her/him) may be sent in advance to the Experts to review before coming for the selection. The candidate should be asked to submit these in 3 sets with the application.
- d. Significant contribution to teaching/academic environment /institutional corporate life.
- e. Adequate Extension and field outreach activities.
- f. Development of course material/Monographs.
- g. Participation in Continuing Education Program.
- h. Any other academic contributions.

The requirement of consistently satisfactory performance appraisal reports, shall be the mandatory requirement for Career Advancement from Lecturer to Lecturer (Senior Scale) and from Lecturer (Senior Scale) to Lecturer (Selection Grade)/Assistant Professor.

Selection Committee

For Lecturer/ Assistant Professor/ Professor

The following committee is recommended for all the levels of promotions/direct recruitment:

1. Chairman, Board of Governors
2. The Principal of the concerned College
3. Head/ chairperson of the Department not below the rank of Professor.
4. a) Vice Chancellor or his nominee- not below the rank of Professor in Technical Institute.
b) Nominee of COA not below the rank of Professor
5. Experts
 - i) For Lecturers two subject experts, out of which one must be present
 - ii) Three subject Experts for Assistant Professor/ Professor, out of which two must be present.

Note:

- i) In case of University Department, Vice Chancellor will be the Chairman of the Selection Committee as well as Dean of the concerned Faculty will be the member of the Selection Committee.
- ii) In case of Government Colleges, where selections are made through Public Service Commission. The Commission must have three subject Experts for which the Public Service Commission must involve University in the selection. The Principal of the college should necessarily be included in the Selection Committee. The Commission may decide the Chairman of the Selection Committee.
- iii) At least four members including two outside Experts must constitute the quorum.

The process of selection should include involve the following in addition to other promoters decided by the Selection Committee:

- a) Assessment of aptitude for teaching and Research
- b) Ability to communicate clearly and effectively
- c) Ability to analyze and discuss.

I have to state that the Council of Architecture at its 78th meeting held on November 7, 2022 considered "Guidelines for Career Advancement (Internal Promotion) Scheme for Faculty Members of Architectural Institutions" and decided to approve the same. These Guidelines have been prescribed by the Council in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 21 of the Architects Act, 1972 and are to be adhered to by all the universities, institutions and competent authorities. A copy of these guidelines is attached herewith for your ready reference.

These Guidelines lay down norms as to how a faculty member would be allowed to move to respective next higher Grade Pay, subject to satisfactory performance and duly approved by the Competent Authority. As teachers are always upgrading themselves in many ways, such upgradation needs to be rewarded in appropriate manner as an incentive and appreciation. Similarly, for teachers in employment for long duration in the same institution and upgrading themselves or actively involved in research or practice need appreciation in the form of promotion to higher cadre. Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) facilitates such appreciation and promotion of faculty members.

In view of the above, all the institutions and universities imparting B.Arch./M.Arch. degree courses in the country as well as competent authorities in the Central/State Governments are requested to implement the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS), as prescribed by the Council, for the betterment of faculty members employed at the Architectural Institutions.

Guidelines for Career Advancement (Internal Promotion) Scheme for Architecture Teachers

The Architects Act, 1972 under Section 21 empowers the Council of Architecture to prescribe minimum standards of architectural education for imparting recognised qualifications by Architectural Institutions. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.1320 of 2022 vide judgement dated 14.02.2022 has held that the Council of Architecture may prescribe the Minimum Standards of Architectural Education without making Regulations.

The Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Madras, vide its judgement dated 21.07.2003, in Writ Petition No. 8806 and 9707 of 2003, had also held that the Regulations framed under the Architects Act, 1972, empower the Council of Architecture to prescribe norms/ minimum standards to meet the requirements of the profession and education of Architecture and the guidelines prescribed by the Council of Architecture have statutory force.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 21 of the Act, the Council of Architecture has formulated these Guidelines for Career Advancement (Internal Promotion) Scheme for Architecture Teachers.

Through these Guidelines it is proposed that a faculty member would be allowed to move to respective next higher Grade Pay, subject to satisfactory performance and duly approved by the Competent Authority.

Teachers are always upgrading themselves in many ways. Such upgradation needs to be rewarded in appropriate manner as an incentive and appreciation. Similarly, for teachers in employment for long duration in the same institution and upgrading themselves or actively involved in research or practice need appreciation in the form of promotion to higher cadre. Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) facilitates such appreciation and promotion. The pyramidal cadre structure will not allow all the teachers of lower cadre to get selected at higher posts hence CAS is an effective tool to avail and reward them for their contribution to the Institution, in Institution building, teaching and research.

Promotion through CAS should be irrespective of the vacancies available in the higher cadre. For example, if all the required positions in the Professor cadre are full and an Associate Professor serving the same Institution at least for five years is eligible for promotion under CAS, he should be designated to the higher post as Additional Professor. Further, in case number of teachers in a particular cadre are more than prescribed as per MSAER 2020, such additional teachers may be counted in the total number of teachers required.

One of the prerequisites for the career advancement approval is the 360° [all round] feedback / evaluation of the teacher by various stakeholders viz.- Head of the Department / Institution, Management and the students. The criteria for assessment are prescribed in the proforma attached herewith. These criteria focus upon the contribution of the teacher in institutional development, departmental development, teaching effectiveness evaluated by students, contribution to society, etc.

The structure and mode of appointment prescribed is as below:

- Qualifications as per the entry level qualifications prescribed by COA for the post of Assistant Professor.

AND

- Completed two Teachers' Training Programs of one week (minimum 5 days) duration in relevant area, recognised by the Council of Architecture.

AND

- Performance indications, experience and publications as per the following table.

- a. Master's Degree in Architecture of relevant allied discipline.

AND

- b. Completion of two Teachers' Training Programs of one week (minimum 5 days) duration in relevant area, recognised by the Council of Architecture at the level of Asst. Professor [Senior Scale].

AND

- c. Performance indications, experience and publications as per the following table.

3. Associate Professor –

Assistant Professor (selection grade) shall be eligible for placement in the Associate Professor cadre through a procedure of selection if she/he satisfies the following:

- a. Qualifications as prescribed by COA for the Post of Associate Professor.

AND

- b. Completion of two Teachers' Training Programs of one week (minimum 5 days) duration in relevant area, recognised by the Council of Architecture at the level of Asst. Professor [Selection Grade].

4. Professor – The candidate should satisfy the following set of requirements.

- a. Qualifications as per the qualifications prescribed by COA for the Post of Professor.

AND

- b. Completion of two Teachers' Training Programs of one week (minimum 5 days) duration in relevant area, recognised by the Council of Architecture at the level of Associate Professor.

AND

- c. Performance indications, experience and publications as per the following table.

5. Senior Professor – The candidate should satisfy the following set of requirements.

- a. Qualifications as per the qualifications prescribed by COA for the Post of Professor.

AND

- b. Ph.D. in Architecture awarded by faculty of Architecture/ Planning.

AND

- c. Minimum ten years' experience in the cadre of Professor.

AND

- d. At least 8 research publications in journals approved by UGC / COA, during the cadre as Professor.

AND

- e. At least two PhDs awarded as guide or co-guide from a recognised university.

OR

Completed at least two architectural projects under institutional consultancy as leader of the project.

***Note:** The candidate applying for Assistant Professor (Selection Grade) should be senior/ lead member of the team for Arch. Projects completed under institutional consultancy and such projects together must have generated revenues of more than Rs. 5,00,000 (As per 2020 valuation)

Incentive for acquiring higher qualification

1. At the time of recruitment as Assistant Professor, three and one advance increments will be admissible to those who hold Ph.D. and M. Arch. Degree respectively.
