A Student Council meeting was convened on 24th November 2025 in the Conference Room of SoECE. Following points were discussed:

1. Syllabus Monitoring

The council discussed the need for continuous monitoring of syllabus coverage across all courses. It was emphasized that timely completion of units and transparency regarding progress will help students stay aligned with academic expectations. Faculty members may be requested to share periodic updates on syllabus status.

2. Projects in Labs for Enhanced Learning

It was proposed that each laboratory course should incorporate at least one meaningful project to promote hands-on learning. These projects should focus on practical applications, innovation, and real-world problem solving to enhance students' technical competency.

3. Course, Placement, and Internship-Related Curriculum

The council highlighted the importance of aligning the curriculum with industry expectations. Suggestions included incorporating placement-oriented modules, increasing internship-linked training, and periodically updating course content to address emerging technologies and skill requirements.

4. Interaction with First-Year Students

It was observed that interaction between the School and first-year students is currently minimal. The council recommended organizing orientation sessions, expert talks, lab visits, and interactive activities to increase their awareness of the School's curriculum, laboratories, career opportunities, and technological domains.

Decisions / Action Points

- 1. Academic coordinators to prepare a monthly syllabus monitoring report.
- 2. Lab in-charges to design and propose project-based learning activities for each lab course.
- 3. A committee to review curriculum components related to placements and internships.
- 4. Plan an outreach programme for first-year students starting next month.
